

SODIUM AND FLUORIDE IN DRINKING WATER

In the Municipality of Kincardine our municipal groundwater well systems have elevated levels of naturally occurring sodium and fluoride. The levels do not pose a significant health risk but if you are on a sodium restricted diet or are watching your intake you may be interested in more information. Below are the most recent results for Sodium and Fluoride in our small systems.
